




Hudson River Park

The Rebirth of the Waterfront

Hudson River Park:

- Five miles from Battery Park to 59th Street
- 550 acres, including over 400 water acres
- Continuous waterfront esplanade
- 13 Dedicated Public Piers
- Limited “park compatible” commercial development

Hudson River Park Act

1. Creates the Hudson River Park Trust as the body to design, build, operate & maintain the park;
2. Includes land use restrictions governing every pier & protecting against commercial over-development.
3. Creates a special marine sanctuary to protect the river's unique habitat and in-water resources.
4. Mandates that the Trust should be financially self-sufficient by keeping revenues within the park.
